Present Perfect Continuous

When is it used?

- For an activity that has recently stopped or just stopped; there is a connection with now.

a. I am tired. I **have been working** in the garden.

b. Why are you so dirty? What **have** you **been doing**?

- For actions repeated over a period of time, when we want to say how long.

a. I've **been playing** tennis for 10 years.

He **has been learning** English since he was ten.

*In simple words: para describir acciones que comenzaron en el pasado y que aún continúan o acaban de finalizar, por ejemplo: We **have been training** for 3 months; she **has been working** all day.

How is it formed?

Subject + HAVE/HAS + BEEN + verb(ING) + complement.

I have been

you have been

he/she/it **has** been

we have been

you have been

they have been

working
