



5.	<i>A device that is placed inside a clock, radio, etc. and that produces the electricity that makes it work.</i>	
6.	<i>A small computing device that you wear on your wrist.</i>

8.	<i>A piece of equipment consisting of two earphones joined by a band across the head that makes it possible to listen to music, the radio, etc. without other people hearing it.</i>

# Likes and dislikes + -ING

Some expressions used to express what you like or not are:  
(Algunas expresiones utilizadas para expresar lo que te gusta o no)

enjoy	don't mind	don't like
like		hate
love		



Look at the following examples:

- 1) I **enjoy playing** videogames.
- 2) I **like making** phone calls to my friends.
- 3) I **love using** my camera to take photos.
- 4) I **don't mind doing** my homework online.
- 5) I **don't like reading** books from the e-reader.
- 6) I **hate using** my desktop PC but my laptop broke down last week.

In the previous examples, it is important to remember that is common to use the “ing” ending after the like and dislike expressions.

The most common thing to do is just add ING, but there are some exceptions:

(En los ejemplos previos, es importante recordar que es común usar la terminación “ing” después de las expresiones que indican gusto o no)



BASE FORM	“ING” – FORM
Work - Catch - Sleep	Working – Catching – Sleeping
Write – Take – Drive	Writing – Taking – Driving Final letter “E” is eliminated
Die – Lie	Dying – Lying
Swim* – Run* – Stop*	Swimming – Running – Stopping
* The final three letters are “consonant – vowel – consonant” that’s why we have double consonant “mm – nn – pp ”	
Study – Play – Buy	Studying – Playing – Buying Final letter “Y” is in the same place

## Verbos de una sílaba

Swim\* - Run\* - Stop\*

Swimming - Running - Stopping

\* The final three letters are "consonant - vowel - consonant" that's why we have double consonant "mm - nn - pp"

Si el verbo es de 2 sílabas y las últimas tres letras son consonante + vocal + consonante,  
**NO SIGUE** esta regla

Ejemplos:

Enter → entering ✓ (enterring **X INCORRECT**)

Happen → happening ✓ (happennning **X INCORRECT**)


## Activity Number 3


